THE LIBRARY DESIRES TO PROVIDE A PLACE FOR PATRONS TO ENJOY THEIR VISIT IN AN ATMOSPHERE THAT IS WELCOMING, SAFE AND RESPECTFUL. THE FOLLOWING IS UNACCEPTABLE AND IS PROHIBITED:

- ◆ LOUD TALKING AND LAUGHING
- ◆ FIGHTING
- ◆ BOISTEROUS BEHAVIOR
- ◆ ABUSIVE OR OBSCENE LANGUAGE OR GESTURES
- ◆ EATING AND DRINKING
- ◆ SMOKING
- ◆ LOITERING
- ◆ IMPROPER ATTIRE
- ◆ ABUSE OF LIBRARY EQUIPMENT
- ◆ WEAPONS
- ◆ PLAYING MUSIC
- ◆ EXCESSIVE DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION

- ◆ HYGIENE THAT INTERFERES WITH THE ORDERLY OPERATION OF THE LIBRARY
- ◆ ILLEGAL BEHAVIOR, WHICH INCLUDES:
 - ◆ ASSAULT
 - ◆ VANDALISM
 - ◆ DRUNK AND/OR DISORDERLY CONDUCT
 - ◆ HARASSMENT
 - ◆ LEWDNESS
 - ◆ THEFT
 - ◆ TRESPASS
 - ◆ CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES

ANIMALS OF ANY KIND ARE PROHIBITED UNLESS SERVING AS AN AIDE ANIMAL OR PART OF A LIBRARY-SPONSORED PROGRAM.

A PARENT, GUARDIAN OR OTHER RESPONSIBLE ADULT OVER THE AGE OF 16 MUST STAY WITHIN A REASONABLE DISTANCE OF A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 8 AT ALL TIMES IN THE LIBRARY. CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 12 MAY NOT BE LEFT AT THE LIBRARY WITHOUT AN ADULT BEING PRESENT TO MONITOR THEM.

VIOLATIONS MAY BE CAUSE FOR REMOVAL FROM THE PREMISES AND/OR LOSS OF LIBRARY PRIVILEGES. ANY PATRON WHO IS AGGRIEVED BY A LIBRARY CONDUCT DECISION MAY CONSULT THE LIBRARY DIRECTOR.
